## News from the WRSA branches

The **Italian Association of Rabbit Science** (*Associazione Scientifica Italiana di Conigliicoltura*, ASIC) was funded in 1976 by a group of young researchers that contributed to the research and technique development in rabbit production at an Italian and international level (Daniele Gallazzi, Claudia

Baldissera Nordio, Marcella Battaglini, Casimiro Crimella, Roberto Parigi Bini). During the first two mandates, prof. Maria Teresa Auxilia of the University of Turin coordinated ASIC activities. After that, every two or three years, a Directive Council, including scientists and coordinators of breeder and technical organizations, has been elected by the ASIC members.

The latest **Directive Council** has been composed by the President Cesare Castellini (University of Perugia), the Secretary-Treasurer Angela Trocino (University of Padova), the Vice-presidents Fabrizio Agnoletti (Istituto Zooprofilattico Sperimentale delle Venezie) and Rossella Pedicone (UnaItalia), the Members: Claudio Cavani (University of Bologna), Elena Circella (University of Bari), Fabio Luzi (University of Milan), Gerolamo Xiccato (University of Padova), Gianni Corbara (Technician) and Francesco Danese (AIA).

ASIC is one of the largest WRSA branches with a number varying from 40 to 70 memberships, from academy, breeder associations and industries. The association continuously and actively acts to diffuse and promote rabbit science at different levels. Thus, it participates to institutional tables for ruling rabbit production in agreement with industries and farmers.

ASIC organized twice the World Rabbit Congress in Italy, i.e. the 3rd WRC in Rome (1984), and the 9th WRC in Verona (2008). Yearly it organizes scientific conferences (e.g. Giornate di Coniglicoltura ASIC in Forlì), and round tables on specific topics, like rabbit housing and welfare, antibiotic resistance, technical innovation, in different locations in Italy, as well as training courses and events for breeders, technicians and veterinaries often in collaboration with the Fondazione Iniziative Zooprofilattiche of Brescia.

## Paper submission process:

First call for a short paper title + synopsis: starting at 15/06/2019 till 15/10/2019

Submission for short papers: starting at 15/09/2019 till 15/11/2019

The submission process will follow a 3-step process:

- **first step:** Submit by mail a one page containing title, author list and address, synopsis and corresponding author e-mail. This will help the scientific comity to build well balance sessions. A notification of acceptance for short paper submission will be send to the corresponding author.
- **second step:** Submit your complete short paper according to the author guidelines, exchange with the referee will give the opportunity to improve the paper. Referee will send notification of whether the paper is accepted as oral presentation or poster
- **third step:** Authors prepare oral presentation or poster according to 12thWRC guidelines.

### VI American Rabbit Congress

Between August 27th and 29th, 2018, the VI American Rabbit Congress was held in the city of Goiania - Brazil. This event brought together professionals from Brazil, Mexico and Argentina, as well as European countries such as Portugal, Hungary, Spain and France, as well as Nigeria. The Congress took place within the schedules of "Zootecnia Brasil" and took place at the PUC Goiania Convalescent Center.

Renowned researchers such as Concha Cervera of the UPV and Thierry Gidenne of INRA as well as young promises participated in the event. There were presented extremely current topics such as rabbit welfare, pet rabbit nutrition and organic rabbit breeding in addition to traditional

## 8th Annual Congress on Rabbit Industry Development in China

The 8th China Rabbit Industry Development Conference (CRID) was held in Ningyuan city (Hunan province, China) from the 2nd to 4th of November 2018, hosted by China Animal Agriculture Association (CAAA) and China Branch of WRSA. The theme of this year conference is industry upgrading. The plenary session and 5 sub-sessions were arranged and mainly focused on rabbit breeding, local rabbit genetic resource protection, non-antibiotic farming and rabbit industry standard etc. There were more than 180 participants to this conference.

A total of 120 communications were received during call-for-paper, which covered reproduction and genetics, breeding, nutrition, biosecurity and welfare, and management etc. Finally total 19 communications were orally presented. Specific sessions were designed for experience sharing and technical exchange among farmers and enterprises. In addition, after the congress a field trip was arranged to visit local farms.
